Angela (Angy) Ahrendt, 44, passed away Friday, August 26 at Greenville, Texas. She was born February 13, 1967, in Wichita Falls Texas to Truett and Fredene Fenter. Angy graduated from Giddings High School, Giddings Texas in 1985. Afterward she attended Ogle Beauty School in Ft. Worth Texas and returned to Giddings and worked as a hair stylist. Shortly thereafter she met the love of her life, Kent Ahrendt from Abilene Texas (originally from Lexington, Texas). They made their home in Abilene. In 1995 Angy and Kent moved to West Tawakoni Texas and then to their current home in Paradise, Texas in 1998. She was a member of the Garvin Methodist Church. Her interests included family, friends, her beloved pets, and feeding and watering the wild animals and birds. She devoted much of her time and energy as a caregiver to family members. She was always first to offer help and her heart to anyone. Angy is survived by her husband, Kent Ahrendt of Paradise Texas, her parents, Truett and Fredene Fenter of West Tawakoni, Texas. Brother, Larry (Dalton) Fenter and family of Springfield, Vermont, Brother Stephen (Brett) Fenter and family of North Bend Washington. She is also survived by her nieces and nephews, Travis, Jason, and Casey, Sophia, Kayty, Rhyann, Tanner, Jay, & Bree. There will be a visitation on Tuesday August 30, 2011 from 6-8 pm at Coker Funeral Home in Jacksboro, Texas. Services will be Wednesday August 31, 2011 at 10 am at Coker Funeral Home Chapel with burial following at Oakwood Cemetery in Jacksboro.
