Charles B. McMennamy was born on October 18, 1918 to William Henry and May (Mackey) McMennamy in Bokchito, Oklahoma. He was the sixth of eleven children. He died February 12, 2008 in Childress, Texas. He was 89 years old. Charles, affectionately known as Charlie, was loved and respected by all who knew him.
