VIEW VIDEO TRIBUTE Cynthia Renea Cross was born July 6, 1970 in Grand Prairie, Texas to Carroll and Betty (Auld) Cantrell. Cyndy passed away Monday June 1, 2009 at her home in Jacksboro at the age of 38 years. Cyndy married William Cross September 15, 1990 at the Wizard Wells First Baptist Church. She worked at the Post Office as a mail carrier and was a member of Bible Baptist Church in Jacksboro.
