



## Doyle "Butch" Gaddis

August 25, 1940 - December 12, 2012

Doyle Wayne Gaddis was born on August 25, 1940 to Cecil "Bud" and Ava Lee Boruff Gaddis in Jacksboro, Texas. He passed away on Wednesday December 12, 2012 in Decatur, Texas. He was 72 years old.

Butch, as he was fondly called, was a United States Army veteran who served in the Vietnam War. He was a retired Civilian Personnel Officer for the US Government. Butch was a Master Mason in the Kemper-Macon Ware Lodge #64 in Falls Church, Virginia; a member of Scottish Rite of Free Masonry and a member of the Grace Baptist Church of Jacksboro, Texas.

He is preceded in death by his parents and his daughter Crystal Lynn Gaddis.

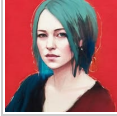
