September 11, 1931 - February 22, 2015

Ed Henry Stewart was born September 11, 1931 in Jacksboro, Texas. he was the son of the Late Mizell and Ornee (Berry) Stewart. Ed was graduate of Jacksboro High School and received a Master's Degree for the University of North Texas. He taught Junior High History in Jacksboro and later owned and operated Ed's Clothes Shop for many years. After he retired, Ed ranched on the Stewart Family Ranch. He was very active in civic affairs of Jacksboro, Ed served on the Gladys Johnson Ritchie Public Library Board and Oakwood Cemetery Board for many years. He was also a member of the Masonic Lodge and the Northwest Texas Field & Stream where he was the host of an Annual Youth Hunt for over 40 years. Ed Henry passed away Sunday, February 22, 2015 in Jacksboro, Texas at the age of 83 years old.

He is survived today by his brother, Robert Lee Stewart; numerous cousins and Special Friends, Ronnie and Lori Smith.

Our wedding was at his parent's house some 50 years ago and Ed was there to share in the experience with us. A few years later, we were able to help Ed prepare for a 50th anniversary celebration for his parents at their home. We visited him on the ranch several times. When he told us that he had sold the old two story ranch house to be moved, my husband, Jimmy, chastised him for getting rid of such a beautiful piece of history. He said that he had lived in old ranch houses his entire life. He wanted a new, modern house so he built one including a hot tub. Ed would call us every once in a while when he needed something in our area. He called Jimmy telling him that he wanted a new, red Mazda pickup and would he go to the dealership here in Hurst and see if they had one. They did, so the salesman called Ed and talked to him a few minutes then handed the phone to Jimmy because Ed wanted to talk to him. Ed told him to give the salesman a down payment check and he would be down the next day to get the pickup. I'm sure many in Jacksboro remember that little red ranch pickup he and Don drove for years and years. Ed loved Chihuahua puppies but the one he had died. He called us and asked us to see if we would find where he could buy another Chihuahua. We did and he came down to get the puppy. It was strange to see big ol' Ed being so happy and gentle with the tiny puppy. He had that one for a number of years. Ed discovered the internet and he shared beautiful scenes, inspirational messages, funny stories and jokes with us. We missed that communication with him when his health began to fail. We, along with his brother Robert in Tennessee, are saddened by this loss but are comforted by all the messages posted at the Coker Funeral Home site.

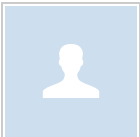
