The Memorial Service for Edward W. McCormick will be held at the First Baptist Church of Bellevue, Texas on Wednesday, March 6th at 11 AM.

Ed was born July 4, 1940, in Wichita Falls, Texas to Mr. and Mrs. Wayne McCormick. He spent his youth in Wichita Falls attending Ben Franklin, Zundy, and graduating from Wichita Falls Senior High.

After graduation, he served in the United States Marine Corps Reserves in the early 1960s and then went on to attend North Texas State University on an athletic scholarship, where he ran track and played football.

It was soon after that he met and married Barbara Barrington. She passed away in 1995. In 2001 he married Mary Keller McCormick, a childhood family friend.

In the early 1970s, he entered into the Oil and Gas Business, serving on the Board of Directors of the North Texas Oil and Gas Association. He was a 32nd Degree Mason and belonged to Masonic Lodge 731 in Amarillo, Texas. Ed was a lifelong member of the First Baptist Church in Wichita Falls.

Ed was preceded in death by his parents, and sister, Beverly McCormick Johnson. He leaves his wife, Mary; son, Kelly Edward McCormick, and wife,

Christy of Richmond, Michigan; stepson, Billy Worley, and wife, Gerri of Graham, Texas; nieces, Shannon Turpin, Jennifer Johnson; and nephews, Jed Johnson and Greg Johnson, all of Memphis, Tennessee.
