June 6, 1917 - January 2, 2010

Harry Herman Gaskin, Jr. was born on June 6, 1917 to Harry Herman and Mattie (Glidewell) Gaskin in Jack County, Texas. He passed away on January 2, 2010 in Jacksboro, Texas. He was 92 years old. He married Willie Mae Neill on October 4, 1942 in San Angelo, Texas. Harry served his country proudly in the United States Navy during World War II. He was enlisted in April of 1943 in Dallas, Texas. He served tours in the Seabees in Europe and the Pacific. He was honorably discharged as a Machinist Mate 1st Class in December of 1945 in Norman, Oklahoma. Harry was an active member of First Baptist Church in Jacksboro and he was retired from the Texas Department of Transportation. He is preceded in death by his parents; a brother John Olen Gaskin who died in World War II; a sister Sylvia Campbell and a son Harry Neill Gaskin. He is survived by his wife Billie Gaskin; a sister Tommye Gay Wilkerson and many extended family members and friends. Services will be Monday at 2 pm at First Baptist Church in Jacksboro. Burial will follow at Oakwood Cemetery in Jacksboro. There will not be a scheduled visitation time.
