June 29, 1941 - October 15, 2022

Jackie Lee Dosier, 81, of Wichita Falls, passed away on October 15, 2022.

Jackie was born June 29, 1941, in Wichita Falls to Bob and Myrtle Dosier. After high school, he joined the US Navy. He served 3 ½ years in Norfolk and two years in California. He served ten months of combat duty in Vietnam, where he was decorated with the Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry with Silver Star.

During his service, he was awarded two bronze stars and a purple heart. During his ten months of combat duty, he was a member of a four-man crew that manned a jet-propelled patrol vessel that patrolled the Mekong Delta. A picture of him manning the 50-caliber gun on the back of the PT boat was on the cover of Life Magazine on January 13, 1967.

After leaving the US Navy, he enlisted in the Army for server years. After leaving the service, he moved to Odessa, Texas where he married his wife, Hazel.

He is preceded in death by his wife, parents, brothers Bobby Joe and R.B., sisters, Katherine Haddox, Melba Dempsey, and Gladys Orrell. He is survived by his twin sister, Jill, husband, J. W. Jackson of Wichita Falls, and many nephews and nieces.
