James "Jim" Marion Hill, 84, passed away peacefully on November 25, 2024, in Lubbock, Texas. A devoted educator, loving family man, and faithful servant, Jim lived a life rooted in kindness, purpose, and unwavering faith.

Born on July 12, 1940, in Coody's Bluff, Oklahoma, Jim was raised in Perrin, Texas. He pursued a lifelong passion for learning, earning a Bachelor's degree from Midwestern State University and a Master's degree in Education from Texas Tech University.
