September 30, 1927 - July 21, 2010

Jimmy Austin “Buddy” Allard was born on September 30, 1927 in Wichita Falls, Texas to Jim Austin and Selma (Jones) Allard. He passed away on Wednesday, July 21, 2010 in Jacksboro, Texas. He was 82 years old. Jim joined the United States Navy at the age of 17 in Seal Beach, California. He proudly served his country from November of 1944 to July of 1946 as a Seaman 2nd Class in an ammunition overall. He received the Victory Medal and American Campaign Medal for Foreign Service and Sea Service in World War II. After his honorable discharge he attended Bible College in Waxahachie, Texas as well as Bible College in Hot Springs, Arkansas. At the young age of 22 he became an ordained minister for Assembly of God Churches. He served churches in Winston, Waynesboro and Laurel, Mississippi; two years as an evangelist in Mississippi; two years in radio ministry in Waynesboro, Mississippi as well as churches in Aransas Pass, San Antonio, Olney and Paradise, Texas. Jim married Eva Delker Cox on December 31, 1977 in Hutchinson, Kansas. He was a member of Squaw Mountain Assembly of God in Jacksboro, Texas. He is preceded in death by his parents; two sisters Wanda “Sunshine” Norville and Melrose Stevens and a brother Bill Aaron Allard.
