John Allen "Buck" Williamson was born on January 21, 1912 to Richard Allen and Maude Ophelia (Stephens) Williamson in Tarrant County, Texas. He passed away on Saturday May 2, 2009 in Fort Worth, Texas. He was 97 years old. He was three years old when he moved with his family to Jack County, Texas in December of 1915. He resided at the Williamson Farm on Puddin Vallen Road the rest of his life until his health necessitated him to reside in Care Centers. During his lifetime he was a farmer, rancher, a school bus driver and owned and operated a welding shop in Jacksboro, Texas. He was a member and deacon of Post Oak Baptist Church. He was preceded in death by his parents and two sisters Susie Baker and Winnie Nolte and six brothers Travis, Dub, Bob, Len, Jack and Dick Williamson. He is survived by his sister Julia Stephan of Fort Worth, Texas and numerous nieces, nephews, extended family and friends.
