John Ray Lindsey was born on August 24, 1926 to Dave and Mary Evelyn (Walters) Lindsey in Jack County, Texas. He passed away on May 2, 2007 in Wichita Falls, Texas. He was 80 years. He was born and raised in Jack County and graduated from high school from Jacksboro High School. He served his country proudly in World War II with the United States Army in the 324th and 44th Infantry Divisions. He married Carol Glendinning on July 28, 1956 in Green Valley, Texas. He attained his undergraduate degree and his law degree from the University of Texas. Mr. Lindsey had a long and esteemed career in law as he served as the County Attorney for Jack County, County Judge of Jack County; District Attorney of Jack, Parker and Wise Counties; State District Judge and Senior District Judge. He was a rancher as well. He gave of his time generously to his community as he was a founding member of the Jack County Sheriff's Posse; member of the Jacksboro Lions Club; Jacksboro Chamber of Commerce, the local VFW and Jacksboro First United Methodist Church. He actively supported the Longhorn Council of the Boy Scouts of America and a longstanding member of the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association. He was a member and Chairman of North Texas Council of Government; member of the Jack County Bar Association and State Bar of Texas Association. He is survived by his wife Carol of over 50 years; his daughter Carolyn Lindsey and husband Walter Jones of Cuervo, New Mexico; his son David Lindsey and wife Pam of Strawn, Texas; sisters Jean Lindsey of Jacksboro and David Marie Hunter of
