John Thomas Sharp, of Antelope, Texas was born on January 15, 1947 to John Thomas and Nina Lois (Barry) Sharp in Bisbee, Arizona. He passed away at his home in Antelope on Sunday April 6, 2014. He was 67 years old.

John married his high school sweetheart and love of his life Cherry Louise Baggett on January 13, 1967 in Wichita Falls, Texas. He was a paratrooper in the 82nd Air Borne and served in Vietnam. He loved his family more than anything and did everything he could to take care of each and everyone of them.
