



Julia Carter Williams

January 3, 1917 - October 20, 2013

Julia Carter Williams was born on January 3, 1917 to Lester and Edie (Foreman) Carter in Jack County, Texas. She passed away on Sunday October 20, 2013 in Wichita Falls, Texas. She was 96 years old.

Julia married Thomas Davis "T.D." Williams on August 9, 1936. She was an active member of the Jack County community including being a member of the First Methodist Church in Jacksboro and the Jack County Home Demonstration Club in Barton Chapel. Julia was a past Worthy Matron of the Eastern Star Chapter in Jacksboro and held an honorary Chapter and State FFA Degree in Texas. She was an adult 4-H leader and a founding member of the Jack County Posse Ladies Auxiliary. She was a member of the Rebecca Jane Fisher Chapter of the Daughters of the Republic of Texas as well as serving as their Chapter Historian and Chaplain. First National Bank bestowed on her the American Cancer Society Award of Courage. Not only was Julia active in the community but perhaps most of all she was a homemaker to her family and a rancher with her husband T.D. In 1989 they were awarded the Agriculture Family of Jack County presented by the Jack County Farm Bureau.

Julia is preceded in death by her husband T. D., her sisters Mary Turner and Ruth Peek, her brother John D. Carter, her son John R. Williams, and her granddaughter Emily Kristine Williams.

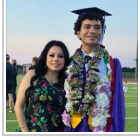
