Pamela Kaye Watson was called Home to be with her Lord and Savior on Saturday, August 30, 2025, in Chandler, AZ. She was born on December 8th, 1964, in Fort Worth, Texas, to parents Ronald E. and Shirley Kitterman Watson.

When she was four years old, her parents moved her first to Celle and later to Hamburg, Germany, where she attended German, British, and international schools. This was the beginning of her lifelong desire to see and experience new and different places.
