



## Patsy Ann (McDonald) Riley

September 25, 1937 - June 21, 2024

Patsy Ann (McDonald) Riley, age 86, (formerly of Jacksboro) entered the presence of the Lord on Friday, June 21, 2024, in Crane, Texas. She was born September 25, 1937, in Saginaw, Texas to Collis Edgar and Sarah Angie (Morrow) McDonald. She was one of 9 children.

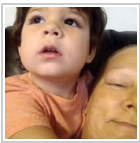
