A bright crescent moon was already rising as if to show the way for Ronald Dwayne Epperson as he left his earthly family and friends early Tuesday evening, October 12, 2010 in Austin, Texas after a toe-to-toe battle with cancer. Although he was born in Jacksboro, Texas August 1, 1952, Ron spent most of his early years in Graham, Texas where he attended school. He was an active and versatile athlete in high school and played all the major sports.
