Ted Burns, 90, went to be with his Lord on Sunday, May 3, 2020 in Mineral Wells, Texas.

A Visitation will be held Thursday, May 7, 2020 at Coker Funeral Home from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm. The Funeral Service will be Friday, May 8 at 10:00 am at First Baptist Church of Perrin with a private burial to follow at Bluebonnet Hill Cemetery in Colleyville.
