Tom Baxter was born June 25, 1947 in Fort Worth, Texas Robert L. and Mary Lou Green Chancellor. Tom passed away Monday, May 19, 2008 in Fort Worth, Texas. He was 60 years old. He and Roxanna Solomon were married April 6, 2008 in Cundiff, Texas. He was employed by Union Pacific Railroad as a freight car mechanic, a master welder and was the wrecker crewman responsible for cleaning up after derailments. Tom was a very patriotic man, serving in the United States Army during the Vietnam War, where he received the Purple Heart. While in the Army he was a member of the Big Red One.
