Vivian Jean Lindsey, 85, of Jacksboro died Wednesday, July 1, 2009, in Jacksboro. Jean was born Oct. 8, 1923, on the Lindsey Ranch in Jack County to the late David and Mary (Walters) Lindsey. She was a rancher and a member of the First United Methodist Church of Jacksboro. She was an active member of her community, and is characterized as a well-loved and important member of the Jacksboro community. She has been a Chamber of Commerce member for 21 years. She has been a Clothes Closet volunteer, and Secretary of Oakwood Cemetery Association for several years, a volunteer and board member of the Jack County Museum, a former member of Business and Professional Women's, where she also served as President, charter member of the Faith Community Hospital Auxiliary. The Jacksboro native graduated from high school in 1940 and was named the 2000 Coming Home Queen. She attended Texas State College for Women (now Texas Women's University), where she graduated with honors, having a degree in English. She was the co-owner of Lindsey Ranch, working as a legal secretary for her brother. As an active member of the First United Methodist Church, Jean has served as a trustee, an assistant Sunday school teacher, sings in the choir and served as its treasurer. She also served as past president of the UMC Women, worked on mission projects, served on Christian Priesthood and held district Methodist office. She was preceded in death by a brother, John R. Lindsey. Survivors include a sister, David Marie (Lindsey) Hunter of Jacksboro; a sister-in-law, Carol Lindsey; a nephew, David

Lindsey and wife Pam; a niece, Carolyn Jones and husband Walter; two great-nephews, Andrew and Jonathan Lindsey; and numerous cousins. There will be a visitation on Thursday evening at Coker Funeral Home from 6-7 pm. Services will be Friday July 3, 2009 at 11 am at First United Methodist Church in Jacksboro, Texas with Pastor David Weber officiating. Burial will follow at Oakwood Cemetery.
