He was 90 years old. Wes, as he was fondly remembered, was a graduate of Texas A&M University. He served his country proudly in World War II in the United States Coast Guard. Wes married Ruth Ernestine Whitaker on November 24, 1955 in Jacksboro. They were extremely active in the community and their church First United Methodist Church. Wes felt a genuine desire to give back to his community which he did in many ways including being a member of the Lion's Club as well as past president of it. He served on the Jack County Appraisal board and was a former director of the Jack County Museum, Jacksboro Chamber of Commerce and Gladys Johnson Ritchie Public Library.
